“The Gospel of God”

Romans 1: 1-7

3. What are the implications of the statement that the gospel was promised beforehand in the Holy Scriptures (2)?
4. What does this Gospel say about the Son and his nature? [Note: in verse 4 the phrase 'Son of God' does not mean that Jesus is God the Son (ie: the second person of the trinity – as true as that is), but rather that he is the Christ or Messiah – the God appointed ruler over the kingdom of God.]
5. What has happened by his resurrection from the dead? ie: What has Jesus now got that he did not have prior to his resurrection?
6. What has happened to Paul in verse 5? What has he been called to do?
7. What response does Paul's gospel result in for those who are converted among the Gentiles?
8. How does your gospel (see question 1) compare with Paul's gospel? Is the impact on one's life the same?
9. Is Jesus Christ your Lord? Do you obey him in your life? Do you need to make any changes as a result of hearing Paul's gospel?
